CLASSIFICATION OF TESTS

- 8. Projective versus Non-projective test of personality:
- Students' personality characteristics and adjustment problems can be measured with the help of projective and non projective tests.
- Projective tests are used to assess students' personal-social adjustment.
- Through these tests, students are provided a series of ambiguous forms or pictures and asked to describe what they see in the forms of pictures. From their description, we analyse what they have projected onto the forms or the pictures.
- Roschach Inkblot Test and Thematic Apperception Test are examples of projective tests.
