

CARMELITE TEA FOR HEALING AND GOOD DREAMS

For those who eschew alcohol:

Instructions:

1. Roughly chop fresh melissa/lemon balm.
2. Place a small handful into a mug and add a cinnamon stick, five cloves and one-quarter teaspoon of coriander seeds.
3. Make a strong infusion by pouring boiling water over the botanicals.
4. Let it steep for at least five minutes, strain and drink.

Carmelite water was originally intended for healing purposes and may be taken internally. Make sure all ingredients are safe for consumption. A typical dose is the size of a wine glass.

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MOONWATER HEALING POTION

Instructions

- Place sacred objects in an iron cauldron or glass bowl.
- Cover them with pure spring water.
- Expose this water to moonlight overnight.
- In the morning add water or use it to bathe

You will need:


- 1 teaspoon dandelion leaf or chopped root


Instructions:

Instructions:

LOVE POTION

Instructions:

1. Choose nine love herbs. Consider these:
 - Damiana
 - Ginger
 - Grains of Paradise Hibiscus pods
 - Lovage
 - Melissa (lemon balm)
 - Peppermint
 - Red clover
 - Rose petals

BLACK SNAKE ROOT POTION
