



Chart: 4 Types of Conditional Sentences

	If-clause (condition)	Main clause (result)
Zero Conditional - used for present, real/factual situations	If I drink coffee at night,	l don't sleep well.
First Conditional - used for future real/factual situations	If I drink coffee tonight,	l won't sleep well.
Second Conditional - used for present or future unreal, imaginary situations	If I drank coffee tonight,	l wouldn't sleep well.
Third Conditional - used for past unreal, imaginary situations	If I had drunk coffee last night,	l wouldn't have slept well.
