type	If - clause	Main clause	Use	example
0	Present simple	Present simple	General truths and laws of nature.	If you mix red and white, you get pink.
1	Present simple	will + infinitive	Real, possible situations in the present or future.	If it rains tomorrow, I will stay at home.
2	Past simple	would + infinitive	Unreal, imaginary situations in the present or future.	If I had more money, I would buy a new car.
3	Past perfect	Would have + past participle	unreal, imaginary situations in the past	If I had studied harder, I would have passed the exam.
