There are 75 pencils in a box. Janet has 6 pencils in a bag. Sharon takes 6 pencils out of the box. How many pencils are left in the box?

Answer:

$$75 \text{ pencils} - 6 \text{ pencils} = 69 \text{ pencils}$$

Gloria removes 24 cards from a jar. There were originally 87 cards and 14 crayons in the jar. How many cards are left in the jar?

Answer:

$$87 \text{ cards} - 24 \text{ cards} = 63 \text{ cards}$$

John starts with 72 erasers and 8 apples. 57 are eaten by a hippopotamus. How many erasers does John end with?

Answer:

$$72 \text{ erasers} - 57 \text{ erasers} = 15 \text{ erasers}$$

Doris has 64 tickets. Jean has 9 tickets. She shares 50 with Elizabeth. How many tickets will Doris have?

Answer:

$$64 \text{ tickets} - 50 \text{ tickets} = 14 \text{ tickets}$$

Christopher has 19 tickets. Helen has with 5 tickets. Helen finds another 19. How many tickets does Helen end with?

Answer:

$$5 \text{ tickets} + 19 \text{ tickets} = 24 \text{ tickets}$$
