## PRESENT PERFECT CONTINUOUS TENSE

It is used to express an action which started before now (or in the past) and has continued up until now (or into the present)

Ex: I have been reading this novel for 5 days.

## PAST PERFECT CONTINUOUS TENSE

is used to express a past action which started in the past and continued to happen after another action or time in the past.

Ex: We had been looking for the wallet for 2 hours when Susan found it.
