E.g. I have taught English for 12 years.

E.g. I have been teaching this class for one hour.

# Emphasize the result of the action

E.g. He has repaired the car.

# Indicate how much/how many

E.g. It has taken six years to write this book.

# Emphasize the duration of the action

E.g. He has been repairing the car for 2 hours.

# Indicate how much/how many in an ongoing process

E.g: He has been studying English for two months.
