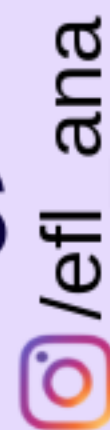


TENSES IN ENGLISH

PRESENT SIMPLE

FACTS AND PERMANENT STATES

- Snow **melts** at 0°C.

HABITS AND ROUTINES

- Daniel **washes** his jeans every week.
- We **don't go** to the cinema on Fridays.

FIRST TYPE CONDITIONAL

- If it **rains** tomorrow, we won't go.

TIMES AND SCHEDULES

- The bus **arrives** at 9.
- Our plane **leaves** at 6:05 this afternoon.

PRESENT CONTINUOUS

ACTIONS HAPPENING AT THE MOMENT OF SPEAKING

- My sister **is watching** TV now.
- They **aren't listening** to me.
- At the moment he's **setting** the washing machine.

ACTIONS HAPPENING IN AN IMMEDIATE FUTURE

- We **are leaving** on Monday.
- In the end she **isn't coming** with us.

REMEMBER!

Action verbs always require a present simple
(see, hear, believe, want, want, know, understand, think, like, love...)
