

Future Continuous Tense or Future Progressive Tense

will be + verb(ing)

e.g. I **will be** singing in the concert tomorrow.

When do we use Future Continuous Tense?

Action in Progress at a Time in the Future

e.g. I **will be** meeting Tom this Saturday.

Interrupted Action in the Future

The word **when** is usually used.

e.g. She will be waiting for you **when** you arrive.

Parallel Actions in the Future

The words **while** or **and** are usually used.

e.g. Sam will be dancing **while** Paul will be singing.
