



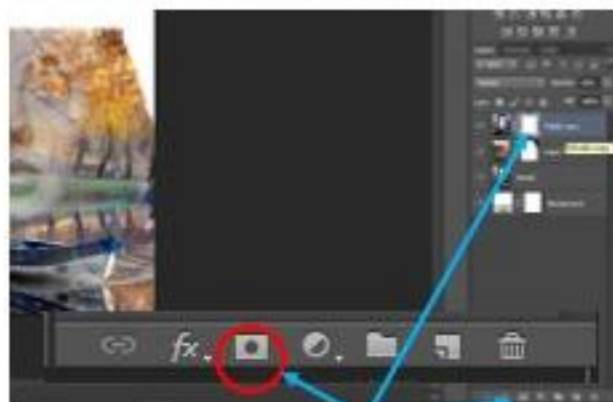
Go back to your portrait image and press CTRL V. This will create a new layer. Change the opacity of the layer on the right-hand side to 50%. This is so you can see how to line up your image with your portrait.



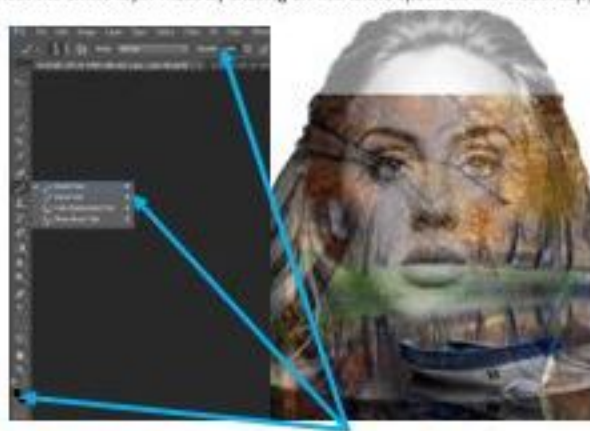
If you need to resize the image then press CTRL T for transformation and edit how big you want your image to be. Press Enter to confirm your selection. Then change the opacity back to 100%.



Make a copy of the model layer by holding down ALT and dragging the model layer above your background. This will be called Model Copy. Change the mode tab from normal to lighten and change the opacity of the layer to 50%.



Select the model copy layer. Select layer mask at the bottom of the layers tab and select the white layer mask by clicking on the white space on the model copy layer.



On the right-hand toolbar. Select the brush tool (8th one down). Change the opacity of the brush to 40% in the top toolbar (you can change the size if you need too) and
