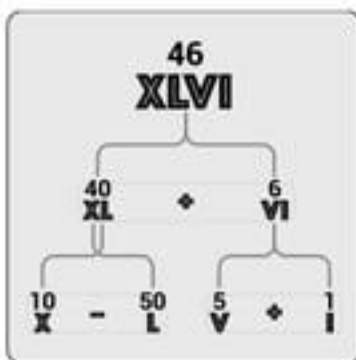

- I** Each Roman Numeral symbol has a decimal value you need to memorize.
- II** You start with zero and add each symbol's value to get a total.
- III** Read each symbol left-to-right, one at a time, adding it's value to the total, but...
- IV** ...if the value of the current symbol is less than the symbol that follows it, subtract the current symbol's value from the next symbol's value and add that result to the total.
