FUTURE PERFECT TENSE



S + will + have + past participle + ...

He will have done it by this evening.



S + will + not + have + past participle + ...

He will not have done it by this evening.

Will + S + have + past participle + ... Will he have done it by this evening?

Usage

Example

To talk about an action that will finish before a certain time in the future

By eight o'clock tomorrow, I will have taken off for Japan.

To talk about an action that will be completed before another event takes place She will have learnt Chinese before she moves to China.

To express conviction that something happened in the near past

The guests will have arrived at the hotel by now.
