

- For all the styling instructions given below, the HTML page must create/use appropriate selector from the profile.css file. There must be no inline or internal CSS used. For colors specified in the instructions, you can choose the nearby color if the mentioned name of the color is not defined in CSS/HTML.
- In body tag, create various semantic tags, header, main and footer.
- **In the header tag, include "Task #3 / Your Full name".** Where you should be writing your name. You can choose appropriate tag to display the text. The text should be 2 times the regular font-size, red colored, verdana font-family, bold and italic.
- Include your name, student number and campus in a footer tag. You can choose appropriate tag to display the text. The text should be regular font-size, yellow colored, calibri font-family, blue background color, and italic.
- For the main tag of the web page must include div tag as container. The div tag must have
  - A picture/image of you referenced from the images folder. Make sure you use appropriate relative path so that your picture will be accessible on the web page on every browser.
  - Picture/Image styling using class: Use a width and height of 200px
  - A header (h1) with your full name
  - A paragraph describing your experience in this course/program so far. Describe what **you like or don't, the courses/topics you are interested in or find it difficult/easy.**
  - A header (h1) that shows "About CountryName... ". Replace CountryName with the name of your home country or the country you want to visit.
  - A Paragraph (at least 3 sentences) that tells me about the why did you choose that country
    - Paragraph styling using the unique ID: Font size should be 1.25 times the default size; include text shadowing (your choice of offset, blur and colour); align to the right
  - A table of 5 facts about the country you mentioned above:
  - First column will include a label regarding a fact (ex. population, capital, etc.)
  - Second column will include the data associated with the label (ex. 1 bn, Ottawa, etc.)
  - Table style using id selector:
    - include a background colour of your choice
    - table width is half of a screen-width
  - First column style using class selector:
    - All text left aligned
    - background color different from table background color
