GOAT

The goat was essential to Israelite culture. Beginning with its sacrificial significance, the animal had many uses. The skin, intact with hair, was tanned and used for making containers for milk, oil, water, and wine, and its hair made a strong cloth.

Twelve 30-day months would bring the year's total to 360 days, but 4 season days brings the count to 364, sans a leap week.

Leap weeks are explained in *The Hebrew Calendar* documentary. They occur every sixth even-numbered year, which keeps the feasts in their proper seasons.
