**In biblical reckoning, days begin in the evening (Genesis 1:5),**

<sup>5</sup> God called the light Day, and the darkness He called Night. So the evening and the morning were the first day. Genesis 1:5 New King James Version (NKJV)

**when the sun goes down (Joshua 8:29; 2 Chronicles 18:34; Mark 1:32),  
and are counted "from evening to evening" (Leviticus 23:32).**

<sup>32</sup> It shall be to you a sabbath of solemn rest, and you shall afflict your souls; on the ninth *day* of the month at evening, from evening to evening, you shall celebrate your sabbath." Leviticus 23:32 New King James Version (NKJV)

**Thus, all God's festivals begin the evening just before the dates listed in this table.**
