In biblical reckoning, days begin in the evening (Genesis 1:5),

when the sun goes down (Joshua 8:29; 2 Chronicles 18:34; Mark 1:32), and are counted "from evening to evening" (Leviticus 23:32).

32 It shall be to you a sabbath of solemn rest, and you shall afflict your souls; on the ninth day of the month at evening, from evening to evening, you shall celebrate your sabbath." Leviticus 23:32 New King James Version (NKJV)

Thus, all God's festivals begin the evening just before the dates listed in this table.
