

## DIFFERENCES BETWEEN



## PAST CONTINUOUS TENSE

It emphasizes what happened when the interruption occured. It shows only continuity.

Example: When I arrived, Lisa was reading newspaper.

## PAST PERFECT CONTINUOUS TENSE

It emphasizes the process of the action before the interruption. It shows continuity and also duration of the action.

**Example:** We **had been looking** for the wallet for 2 hours when Susan found it.
