



Calendar Interop Tools

Exchange server configuration

This tool aids you in setting up an availability address space on your Exchange server to fetch availability information from the Google servers. It also designates the account that Google can use to fetch availability information from Exchange server (this is the same account for which you need to enter the credentials in Google administrator console). This tool will show you PowerShell code that you can enter into the Exchange Management Shell to do this.

To use, upload the credentials for your Google Role Account, tell the tool which version of Exchange you are using, what availability address space you wish to set up, and enter the email address of Exchange Role Account.

Select the credential file for your Google Role Account.
