

Title Page

Header

All pages need a header with the title of the paper and a page number.

- title
 - left-aligned
 - no more than one line in length
 - all UPPERCASE LETTERS
- page numbers
 - right-aligned
 - title page is number 1
- Arial 12 point font (See [Changing the Default Font](#) to change font to Arial.)
- leave space between a long title and the page number

Content Format

- double-space lines
- start text after 2 paragraph returns
- centre content

Content and Sequence

- title of paper in Title Case Capitalization
- student name
- student number
- course name and/or course code
- course instructor
- due date
