Favorite Things

Ask everyone to create a list based on the agreed category. Categories may include non-work related items like TV shows, songs, foods, etc. It may also use work-related categories like favorite product features and company events.





Two Truths and a Lie

Participants should prepare 3 interesting facts about them, one of which is a lie. Each member can vote which statement they think is just a lie and once everyone has voted, that same employee can now reveal the correct answer.





Take a Picture

Take a photo depending on the agreed subject and share a little history about the item. Desk item or shoes of the day are some of the samples.







Time Machine

Look into each employees' what ifs or future plans. Sample questions include:

- If you can go back to any of your younger selves, at what age would you choose to go back to?
- If you can go to the future, what particular aspect of your life would you have checked first?
- If you can give one piece of advice to your 7-year old self, what would it be?





Would You Rather

Ask participants any of these or come up with your own:

- Would you rather be the richest person in the world or the smartest?
- Would you rather be caught doing bathroom singing or making extremely dumb faces?
- Would you rather have no taste buds or be color blind?
