PRESENT CONTINUOUS WITH A FUTURE MEANING - 1

- a) When you are talking about what you have already arranged to do, use the present continuous. Do not use the present simple:
 - What are you doing tomorrow evening?
 - I'm going to the theatre.
 - Are you playing football tomorrow?
 - Yes, but Tom isn't playing. He has hurt his leg.
 - Ann is coming tomorrow.
 - Oh, is she? What time is she arriving?
