

# PRESENT CONTINUOUS WITH A FUTURE MEANING - 1

a) When you are talking about **what you have already arranged to do**, use the present continuous. Do not use the present simple:

- What **are you doing** tomorrow evening?
- **I'm going** to the theatre.
- **Are you playing** football tomorrow?
- Yes, but Tom **isn't playing**. He has hurt his leg.
- **Ann is coming** tomorrow.
- Oh, is she? What time **is she arriving**?
