THE PRESENT CONTINUOUS WITH A FUTURE MEANING

You can use the present continuous to express your plans for the future.

A: What are you doing tomorrow, Sam?
 B: I'm meeting Zaid and we're going to the cinema.
 A: Are you coming to the party on the evening?
 B: Oh, yes, I'm coming. I'll meet Sam. Because she is working for parents' meeting evening.

Present Continuous

Affirmative		
I am	I'm	reading
He/She/It is	He/She/It's	reading
You aren't/You are not	aren't/aren't	reading

Rule: subject + am/is/are + verb-ing

Examples: I am reading. He is reading. You aren't reading.

Negative		
I am not	I'm not	reading
He/She/It is not	He/She/It isn't	reading
You aren't/You are not	aren't/aren't	reading

Rule: subject + am/is/are + not + verb-ing

Examples: I am not reading. He is not reading. You aren't reading.
