

Instructions for completing [IRS Form 8843](#)

- i. At the top of the form, enter the dates of the tax year, Jan 1 – December 31
- ii. Write your first and last names as they appear on your passport.
- iii. If you have a social security number, write it in the field labeled “US Taxpayer Identification Number”. Otherwise leave it blank.

- iv. Under “Address in Country of Residence” put your or your family’s most current address outside of the United States. This address does not have to be in the country that issued your passport, but must be outside of the United States.

b. List all current passport numbers. Do not list numbers of expired passports.

4a. List the number of days you were present in F-1 status in past three years. Do not include days present in any other status.

b. Subtract the number of days you were present in United States in 2018 from 365. The result is the number of days you’ll enter in this field. For example, if you were present for 180 days in 2018, $365 - 180 = 185$ put 185 in that field. If you do not know the exact number of days use your best estimate.
