<b>Squashes / Melons:</b> Cucumber, Gourds, Crookneck, Cantaloupe, Honeydew, Watermelon, Winter Squash, Zucchini	Yellow	Yellow	Green	Green	Yellow
<b>Herbs (Perennial):</b> Anise-Hyssop, Borage, Comfrey, Lavender, Sage, Thyme/Oregano	Green	Yellow	Yellow	Green	Green
<b>Leafy Greens:</b> Arugula, Chicory, Dandelion, Lettuce, Bok Choy/Pac Choy, Kale, Collard, Mustard, Chard	Green	Yellow	Yellow	Red	Yellow
<b>"Nightshades":</b> Eggplants, Peppers, Tomato, Tomatillo, Tobacco	Green	Yellow	Green	Red	Red
<b>Beans:</b> Bush Beans, Cow Peas, <u>Hyacinth Bean</u> , Lima Beans, Pole Beans	Yellow	Green	Yellow	Green	Green
<b>Roots and Bulbs:</b> <u>Carrots</u> , Beets, <u>Parsnips</u> , Turnips, Radishes, Fennel, Kohlrabi, Onions, Leeks	Green	Green	Yellow	Yellow	Green
<b>Heads and Shoots:</b> Broccoli, Cabbages, Cauliflower	Green	Yellow	Red	Red	Yellow

### Color Key

(think of a traffic signal):



**Red:** Unlikely to be seeded or grown successfully.

**Yellow:** Typically can be seeded in mild winter climates.

**Green:** Ideal time for starting from seed

**Light Blue:** Works for container gardens or constrained spaces

Easier Crops Coded in **Green**, More Challenging Crops Coded in **Brown**; **Underlined Crops**

Must Be Direct Seeded in Order to Produce A Viable Crop
