

Form W-2 Employee Instructions

What is form W-2 and how does it work?

Box a: Your Social Security Number.

Box b: Your employers EIN (Employer Identification Number).

Box c: The legal address of your employer. This may or may not be the actual address of where you work.

Box d: The control number that's used by your employer's payroll department. This may be blank.

Box e and f: Your legal name, as it reads on your Social Security card, appears in box (e) and your mailing address is reported in box (f).

Box 15: Your employer's state and state tax identification number.

Box 16: The total amount of taxable wages for state tax purposes, if you are subject to state taxes.

Box 17: The total amount of state taxes withheld from your wages for the year.

Box 18: If you are subject to local, city or other state income taxes, box (18) reports those wages.

Box 19: The total amount withheld from your wages for local, city or other state income taxes.

Box 20: Is the legal name of the local, city or other state tax being reported in box (19).

Copy A For Social Security Administration — Send this entire page with Form W-3 to the Social Security Administration; photocopies are **not** acceptable.

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Box 1: Your total taxable wages, tips, prizes and other compensation for the year, minus certain elective deferrals, such as 401(k) plans, pretax benefits or payroll deductions.

Box 2: The total federal income tax withheld from your pay during the year.

Box 3: Total wages that are taxed for Social Security.

Box 4: Total Social Security taxes withheld from your pay for the year.

Box 5: All your wages and tips that are taxed for Medicaid.

Box 6: Total amount of Medicare tax withheld from your pay for the year.

Box 7: Any tips that you reported.

Box 8: Any allocated tips that your employer has figured attributable to you.

Box 10: Total amount deducted from your wages for dependent care assistance programs. It may also include contributions made by your employer for dependent care on your behalf.

Box 11: Total amount distributed to you from your employer's non-qualified deferred compensation plan.

Box 13: Your employer checks the applicable box that pertains to you.

Box 14: Anything that doesn't have a specific box goes here.
