## Red flags in developmental delay:

- Early failure to reach milestones (e.g. not smiling by 12 weeks)
- Abnormal tone, posture, power or head circumference
- A history of significant problems in the pregnancy or delivery
- Early hand dominance (before 2 years is very likely to indicate a problem)
- Developmental regression
- Child protection concerns
- Severe delay
- Delay in two domains at presentation
- After initial assessment, failure to make any developmental progress at follow-up GPpaedsTips.blogspot.co.uk
