

SOME FACTS ABOUT SEPSIS IN CHILDREN

- SEPSIS IS NOT BINARY
 SEPSIS IS A CLINICAL DIAGNOSIS
 SEPSIS IS A SPECTRUM
- SEPSIS EVOLVES
 SEPSIS IS OFTEN PRECEDED BY AN APPARENTLY BENIGN ILLNESS
- THE VAST MAJORITY OF CHILDREN WITH FEVER AND TACHYCARDIA DO NOT HAVE SEPSIS
- WE HAVE NO HIGHLY SENSITIVE OR SPECIFIC WAY OF IDENTIFYING SEPSIS IN CHILDREN
- WE HAVE NO IDEA WHETHER WE ARE CURRENTLY IMPROVING THE SENSITIVITY OR REDUCING THE SPECIFICITY OF THE DETECTION OF SEPSIS
