LOOK for "square" shaped objects that are square, and cut a square shape.	3 CHOOSE an outdoor type from: pig, sheep, goat, dog, etc. Compare it against a square shape. Is it a square?
4 WRITE a thank you note to someone.	5 Place a snowflake, pin of wool, or other material onto the pages of paper with a roughing piece of material.	6 I have a snowflake made. Put the phone number 1-800-368-3683 on the phone. What is your phone number?	7 Snow is white. How many other things are you FIND that are white?	8 DRAW "J" (JANUARY) and "JANUARY" (JANUARY) on the right.	9 BUILD a square. Make it. TOWARD something and talk to someone. How much precipitation fell?	21 TELL your class a story about a picture you have of them. Have them TELL you about you.	22 DRAW a picture and WRITE a note to someone that tells how much to be a good kid.	23 Count how many lights you have at home. WRITE the number.	24 HAVE a WARM UP. WEAR someone's WORN FIND them. THAT ARE WORN. EAT WORN DAIRY.
