Responsibilities for certified diabetes educator

- Contributes to and participates in a continuous quality improvement process to measure all education programs and to identify and address opportunities for improvement
- Lead clinical personnel
- Meets all other expectations and responsibilities as related to diabetes education, and performs other duties as assigned
- Assesses patients' nutritional needs and prepares nutritional care plans
- Documents records completely and accurately
