Affirmative

S + have/has + past participle

I have tried sushi before.

Form

Negative

S + have/has + not + past participle

I have not tried sushi before.

Interrogative

Have/has + S + past participle Have you tried sushi before?

Example	Adverb
I have been to England.	just
I have been to Paris three times.	already
I have already lost my job.	Yet
I have known James for four or five years.	Since
John has just missed the bus, so he will be late.	Never
I have live hear since 2004.	Ever
