

Ada Lovelace 10 December 1815 - 27 November 1852 an early computer programmer who worked on the Analytical Machine

Grace Hopper December 9, 1906 - January 1, 1992

first woman to received a PhD in math at Yale, created COBOL, an early programming language

Katherine Johnson August 26, 1918 –

a NASA mathematician known for calculating complex orbital mechanics

Maryam Mirzakhani 12 May 1977 – 14 July 2017

mathematician who famously developed many important "billiards" universes

Marie Curie 7 November 1867 – 4 July 1934

discovered radioactivity; first person to win 2 Nobel Prizes

Rosalind Franklin 25 July 1920 – 16 April 1958

famous for her work on graphite, but later for her work with DNA & RNA

Laura Bassi October 1711 - 20 February 1778

physicist who studied electricity and became the first female professor in Europe

Hildegard of Bingen 1098 – 17 September 1179

Germany's first female physician & a founder of the Natural Sciences field

**Ynés Mexía** May 24, 1870 – July 12, 1938

a botanist known for discovering and collecting plant specimens from areas of Mexico and South America

Jane Goodall 3 April 1934 –

a primatologist famous for being an expert in chimpanzee behavior

Maria Montessori August 31, 1870 – May 6, 1952

a physician who studied childhood diseases & developed an educational system now named after her
