How to use a Dictionary?

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Prescriptions: Phonetic transcription of the word to show pronunciation and stressed syllables. The apostrophe for stressed syllables.

Part of Speech: Tells class, noun, verb, adjective, preposition, or adverb.

Number: Tells the number of the word in the dictionary.

Definition: A sentence or word or the phrase. Multiple lines necessary.

Origin: Shows the language from which the word has originated.

Word Form: Shows plural form of every word.

Example: 127
marry / marry
message [ˈmesɪdʒ] (n) 1. A statement made or read before a gathering, a writing (such) brief message. 2. A basic, thesis or lesson; a moral; a play with a message.
plural messages (Middle English, from Old French, from Medieval Latin *missaticum*, from Latin *missus*, past participle of *mittere*, to send.)
