PHYSICIAN

Average annual income:
\$187,876 (\$15,656/month)

REQUIREMENTS:

- M.D.

Minimum requirements to obtain M.D.:

- Bachelor's Degree (4 years, avg cost \$34,740)
- MCAT (Medical College Admission Test, \$305)
- Medical School (4 years, avg cost \$207,866)
- Residency Program (3-8 years, can earn salary)
- USMLE (US Medical Licensing Examinations \$3,320)

Other things to consider, after obtaining M.D.:

- Cost of malpractice insurance premiums
- Overhead of a private practice (if not employed by hospital)

BENEFITS:

- Job satisfaction from patient care
- Mental stimulation
- Income (based on # patients)

ARBONNE NVP

Average annual income:
\$258,000 (\$21,500/month)

REQUIREMENTS:

- \$79 Consultant ID
- Age 18+

Suggested, but nothing is specifically required:

- Products to demo (nothing to stock or deliver)

Average time to promote to NVP:

- 4 years of consistently working 10-15 hrs/week (the fastest anyone can promote to NVP is 4 months)

BENEFITS:

- Job satisfaction from helping others
- Mental stimulation from personal development
- Annual paid trip to Maui (with a guest)
- Mercedes-Benz cash bonus
- Business is willable
- Birthday flowers, holiday gifts
- Income (unlimited)
