

MID FUNCTION IN EXCEL

MID FUNCTION IN EXCEL is used to extract and get a particular number of characters from the middle of a text string.

SYNTAX & ARGUMENTS


=MID(text, start_num, num_chars)

- **text** – Specify text from which you want to extract the sub-string.
- **start_num** - Enter position of text string from which to start extracting from.
- **num_chars** –Specify the number of characters to extract from start position.

The *text* argument may either manually enter the text (within double-quotes) or use a cell reference.

EXAMPLE

Suppose you want to extract two letters starting from third position in excel. In that case, use the following formula: =MID(A2,3,2)
