MID FUNCTION IN EXCEL

MID FUNCTION IN EXCEL is used to extract and get a particular number of characters from the middle of a text string.

SYNTAX & ARGUMENTS

=MID(text, start_num, num_chars)

- <u>text</u> Specify text from which you want to extract the sub-string.
- <u>start_num</u> Enter position of text string from which to start extracting from.
- num_chars -Specify the number of characters to extract from start position.

The *text* argument may either manually enter the text (within double-quotes) or use a cell reference.

EXAMPLE

Suppose you want to extract two letters starting from third position in excel. In that case, use the following formula: =MID(A2,3,2)
