

# PRESENT TENSE

## PRESENT PERFECT CONTINUOUS TENSE

### AFFIRMATIVE SENTENCES

- In case of 1<sup>st</sup> person, 2<sup>nd</sup> person singular & plural & 3<sup>rd</sup> person plural 'Have been' + First form of verb + ing is used.
- In case of 3<sup>rd</sup> person singular 'Has been' + First form of verb + ing is used.
- To express time 'for and since' are used.

### NEGATIVE SENTENCES

- 'Has or Have + Not + been' + First form of verb + ing is used.
- To express time 'for and since' are used.

### INTERROGATIVE SENTENCES

- 'Has or Have' is used before subject. First form of verb + ing is used.
- Sign of interrogation is used.
- To express time 'for and since' are used.
