

blank calendars

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DIRECTIONS:

Print and have students design the months' cover pictures. If you have a small class, you could have each student do one month. Each student could also fill out a page for themselves. Pages can also be stapled together to make a calendar booklet. The little squares in the corners of each day box could be used for the day numbers or could be used for symbols/coloring if you have classroom codes, like green for a good day, X for absent, etc...

IDEAS FOR USING THE CALENDARS:

These are just a few suggestions for using these calendars. Come up with your own ideas to get even more fun and use out of them.

- **NUMBERING:** Practice filling out the numbers in the months properly.
- **HOLIDAYS:** After the calendar is properly filled out, locate major holidays and put a sticker/note/ words/etc... on these days.
- **BIRTHDAYS:** After the calendar is properly filled out, locate and label family or classmate birthdays.
- **MAKE YOUR MARK:** After the calendar is properly filled out, keep track of things like attendance, getting chores done, eating properly, bathroom habits, etc... in the boxes. You can use the small rounded boxes inside each day or the large boxes for each day. You might try coloring them certain colors that fit a code of behaviors or putting stickers on them, like gold star days, etc... These are also great places to keep track of school days and non-school days.
