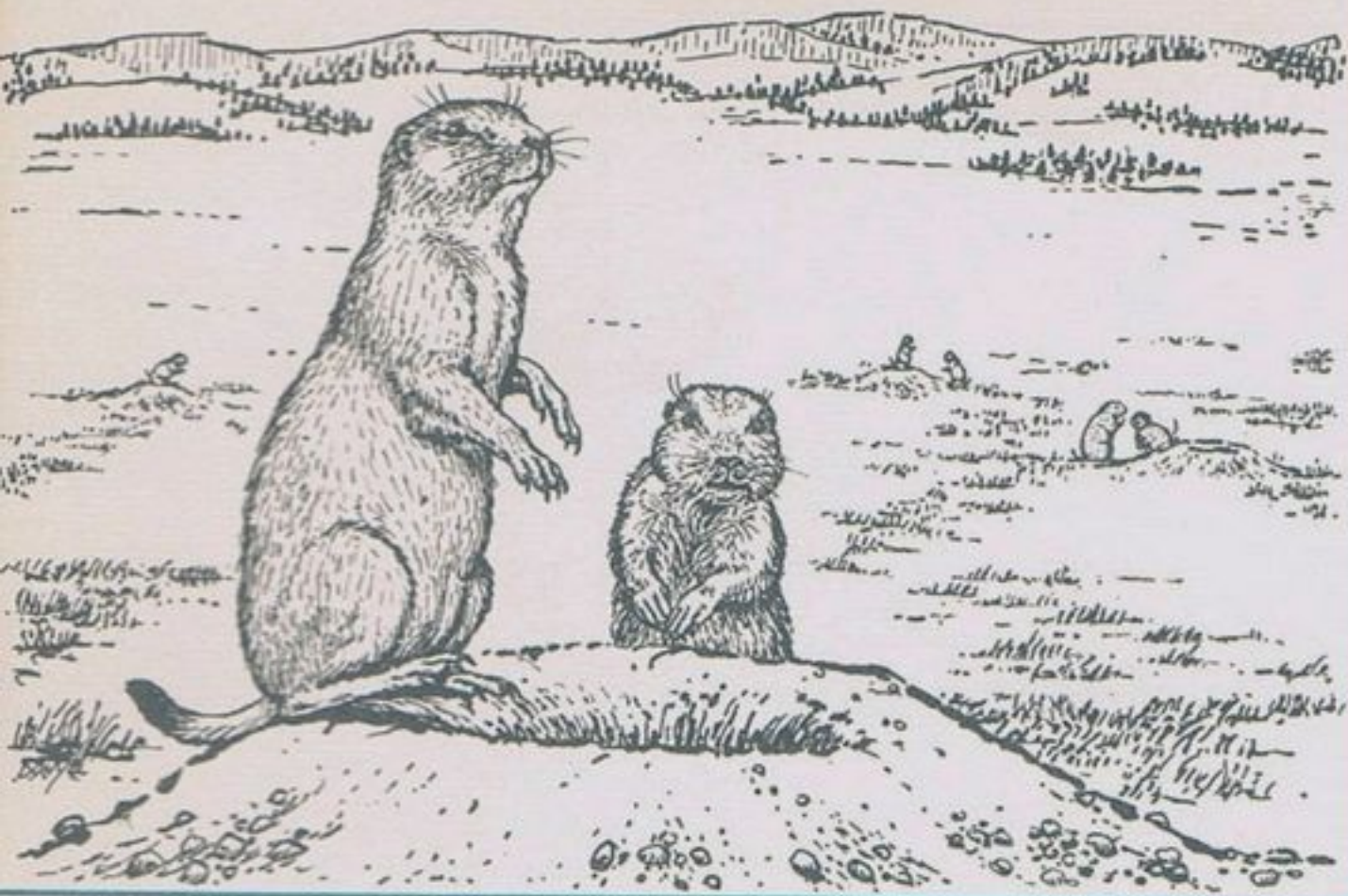




BLACK-TAILED PRAIRIE DOG This heavy-set little animal has coarse yellowish fur and a black-tipped tail. A social creature, he lives in colonies marked by a group of low mounds of dirt and sand excavated from burrows. He inhabits dry prairies and can sometimes be seen sitting upright on a mound, watching for danger. If danger comes, he gives a shrill whistle or a series of barks. Eating mostly green vegetation, he competes with grazing stock for food. His relative, the smaller White-tailed Prairie Dog, prefers high country and mountain valleys.
