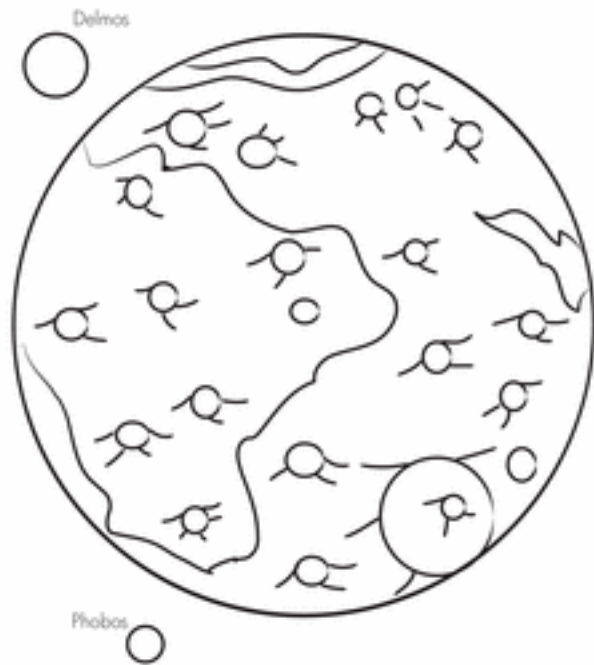




The Solar System

Mars



Mars is the fourth planet from the sun and is about one third the size of the Earth. It has been tracked in the night sky since the time of the ancient Egyptians.
