III Discrete vs Continuous Variables

- Discrete Variables:
 Can take on only certain values along an interval
 - the number of sales made in a week
 - the volume of milk bought at a store
 - the number of defective parts

- Continuous Variables:
 Can take on any value at any point along an interval
 - the depth at which a drilling team strikes oil
 - the volume of milk produced by a cow
 - the proportion of defective parts
