
Lab Equipment Crossword Puzzle

- Used to prepare solutions to an accurate volume.
- Used to secure glassware to a ring stand.
- Used to light a Bunsen burner.

- Used to support a crucible during heating.
- Used to hold or clamp laboratory glassware and other equipment in place, so it does not fall down or come apart.

- Used to hold crucibles.
- Used to measure temperature in Celsius.

- Used to measure small amounts of liquid very accurately.
- Used to measure a precise volume of a liquid.
- Frequently used as a heat source in the absence of flammable materials.
- Used to heat liquids for evaporation.
- Used to transfer liquids or fine-grained materials into containers with small openings.
- Used to crush and grind materials.
- 12. Used for stirring and mixing.

- Used for dispensing an accurate volume of a liquid.
- Used to measuring mass.
- Used to hold several test tubes at one time
- Used to pick up beakers.
- Used to support a container, such as a beaker, on a ring stand while it is being heated.
- Used to pick up or hold small objects.
- Used to hold solids while they are being weighed or to cover a beaker.
- Used with a ring stand to hold glassware.
