#### Express general truths

E.g. It rarely rains in the desert.

### Indicate present habits

E.g. The birds return to the island every morning.

#### Express timetable events

E.g. The plane to London takes off at 6:30 a.m.

### Indicate permanent states

E.g. I like the new James Bond film.

#### Describe actions happening now

E.g. She is reading a newspaper upstairs.

# Express annoying habits (+ always)

E.g. You're always forgetting to pay the bills.

## Describe future arrangements (informal

E.g. She's getting married on 3 November.

#### Express temporary states

E.g. She's working at the museum until the end of this month.
