Instructions

When you print, make sure Page Scaling is set to NONE in the print options dialogue box.

- Place printed paper on a hard surface with heel line flushed to the wall. (fold paper if necessary)
- Place child's heel on bottom line against the wall.
- The end of the longest toe will correspond to a size on the left.

Age Size Chart

If you can't measure your child's foot please use the following charts. **Keep in mind that this is a standardized chart and every shoe runs differently in size. Please take note to our recommendations on size while shopping for individual shoes.**

infant 0 - 24 months		
age	inches	size
0-3 months	-	0-1
3 - 4 months	-	2
5 months	-	3
6 months	-	4
6 - 7 months	-	5
7 - 9 months	-	5 - 6
9 -12 months	-	6 - 8
1 - 2 years	5 13/16" - 6 1/8"	9 - 10

FIT TIP: When your infant is 12 to 18 months old, their feet grow over a half of a shoe size every 2 months. Fittings should accommodate this rate.

toddler 2 - 4 years		
age	inches	size
2 - 3 years	6 1/8" - 6 1/2"	9 - 10
3 - 4 years	6 1/2" - 6 13/16"	10 - 11

FIT TIP: A child 18 months to 2 1/2 years old will need to be fitted for new shoes every 3 months. Ages 2 1/2 to 4, should be fitted every 4 months.

youth 4 - 7 years		
age	inches	size
4 - 5 years	6 13/16" - 7 1/8"	11 - 12
5 - 6 years	7 1/8" - 7 1/2"	12 1/2 - 1
6 - 7 years	7 1/2" - 8 1/2"	1 - 3

FIT TIP: From ages 4 to 6 years old, the growth rate slows down and you should get a fitting twice a year. Allow room for feet to grow by changing the shoes and socks every few months to accommodate your child's natural growth process through the years.
