World Juggling Day: Invite a juggling expert to your library or show kids a beginner tutorial by Taylor Tries. Just make sure your books aren't being used for practice!

Father's Day: Read A Father's Love by Hannah Holt, Illustrated by Yee Von Chan, to learn about fatherhood in the animal kingdom.

Juneteenth: Today commemorates the emancipation of American slaves and celebrates Black culture. Read A Flag for Juneteenth by Kim Taylor and learn more about her quilting illustration technique.

Tomorrow is the first day of summer and International Yoga Day! Take kids outside under a tree with a beach towel or yoga mat to stretch out and welcome the season.

First Day of Summer: Read And Then Comes Summer by Tom Brenner, illustrated by Jaime Kim. Create a large tally chart for kids to share their favorite summertime activity.
