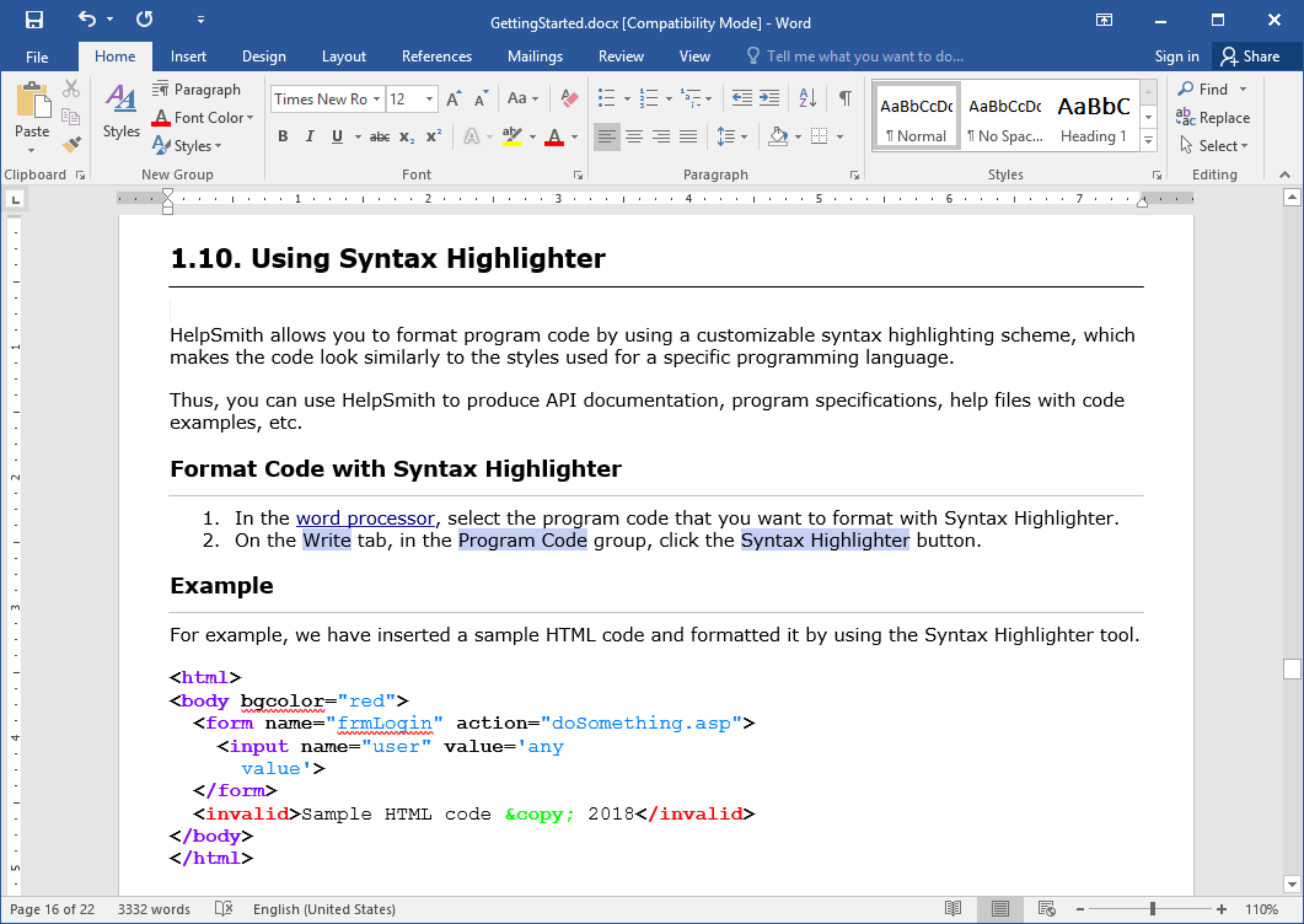




1.10. Using Syntax Highlighter

HelpSmith allows you to format program code by using a customizable syntax highlighting scheme, which makes the code look similarly to the styles used for a specific programming language.

Thus, you can use HelpSmith to produce API documentation, program specifications, help files with code examples, etc.

Format Code with Syntax Highlighter

1. In the [word processor](#), select the program code that you want to format with Syntax Highlighter.
2. On the [Write](#) tab, in the [Program Code](#) group, click the [Syntax Highlighter](#) button.

Example

For example, we have inserted a sample HTML code and formatted it by using the Syntax Highlighter tool.
