### Environmental protection and employment in Germany



There is a long-standing tradition of Federal Government Agency publications on the situation of environmental protection. New estimates have been issued every four years since 1990 in Berlin which record the "gross employment impact" of environmental protection, that is, the employment effects of environmental protection. This includes the employment effects of environmental protection (e.g. forest and forest) services (e.g. energy-saving consulting) or a direct employment effect with jobs in environmental protection such as within environmental agencies or other conservation associations.
