

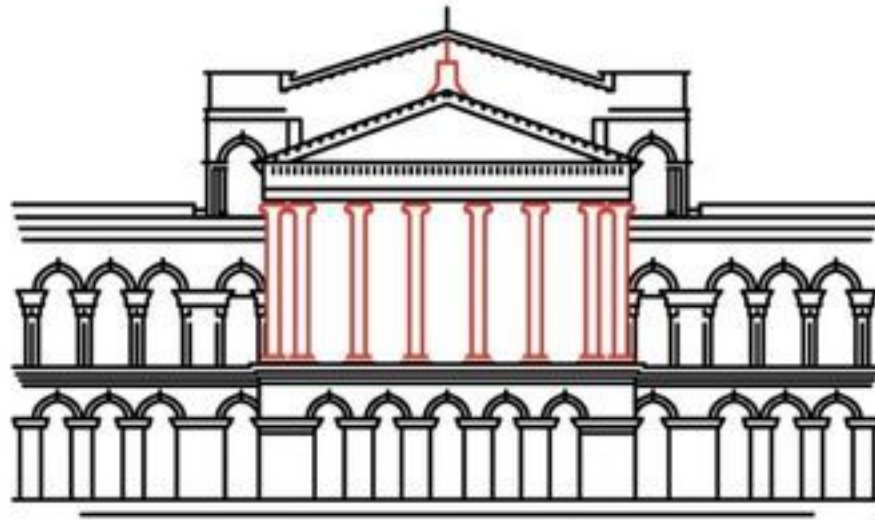

THE KARNATAKA HIGH COURT



Has said that a wife can claim maintenance under two unique enactments, particularly after having been granted maintenance under a particular statute.

A single judge bench of Justice M Nagaprasanna dismissed a petition filed by the husband challenging a order passed by the Family Court granting interim maintenance of Rs.30,000 to his wife under under Section 24 of the Hindu Marriage Act. He argued that the wife was already in receipt of Rs. 20,000 maintenance in proceedings established under Section 12 of the Protection of Women from Domestic Violence Act, 2005.
