



LANGUAGE RESOURCE: SIGN LANGUAGE

The use of simple signs with little ones can serve as bridge to single words and increase verbal expression. Use your hands to show the child what the sign looks like. If he/she cannot imitate the sign yet, use "hand-over-hand" prompting to help your child form the sign.
