Past Continuous

We make the Past Continuous with was / were+ ...ing

AFFIRMATIVE

I / he / she / it was singing

you / we / they were singing

NEGATIVE

I/he/she/it wasn't singing

you / we / they weren't singing

INTERROGATIVE

Was I / he / she / it singing?

Were you / we / they singing?

We use the Past Continuous to express:

a) Actions in progress at a moment in the past.

E.g.: last night at 9 o'clock I was reading a book.

b) Describing a scene.

E.g. It was an awful morning. It was raining heavily and the wind was blowing.

c) Actions happening at the same time in the past.

E.g.: My mother was cooking while I was reading a book.
